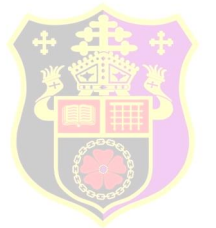

Key Information for Parents, Carers and Pupils on Returning to School from 8th March 2021

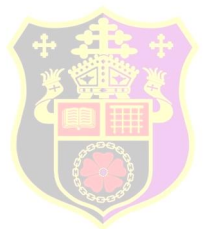


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The guidance from Central Government is for **all** pupils to return to school from 8th March.

This will be phased but all pupils will be back to full education that first week.

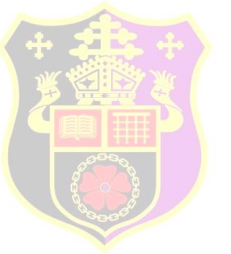
We will also be conducting the Covid Testing programme during the first two weeks

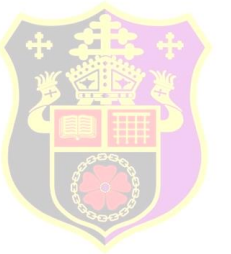
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The measures that were in place prior to Christmas will remain. Details are included within this presentation but include:

- Staggered starts and ends to the day
- Staggered breaks and lunches
- Zoned areas of school
- Pupils remaining for the most part in their lessons
- Covid secure measures such as hand washing, face coverings etc

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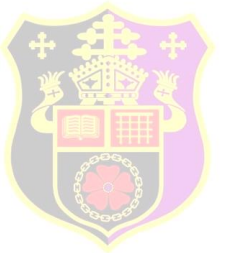
COVID-19 Symptoms

- If your child displays any of the following symptoms **you must keep them at home and not send them to school. (Inform school immediately)**
 - A new dry continuous cough
 - A high temperature
 - A loss of smell or taste
- You should get them tested and self isolate unless the test result is negative. (We will require evidence of this test result)

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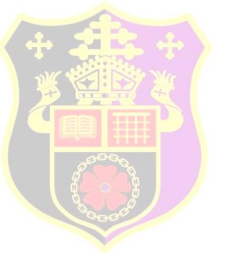
Pupils will return over the course of the first few days between 8th March and 11th March.

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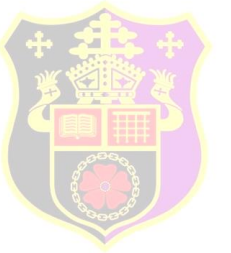
COVID-19 Factors in School

- It is important that you talk to your child before returning about keeping safe in school and that they understand the seriousness of the situation.
- There will be measures in school that we will be expecting all pupils to follow. Please remind them of the importance of the following:
 - Being sensible around school
 - Keeping 2m apart wherever possible (this will be difficult we know)
 - Sanitising and washing hands regularly
 - Not touching other pupils
 - Keeping to their zoned areas including at break and lunch
 - Making their way to and from school sensibly
 - Wearing face coverings where required



Important

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Face Coverings

Pupils are expected to bring their own face coverings to school every day.

It is parents responsibility to ensure that pupils bring their own and it is a reasonable expectation for you to provide these.

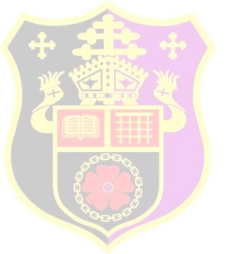
Face coverings are to be worn:

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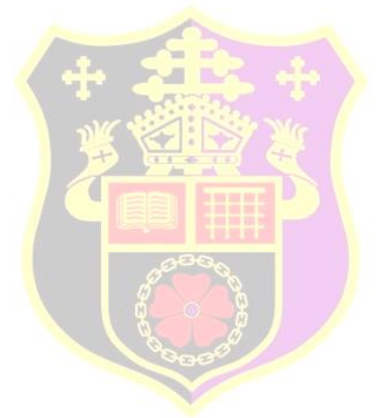


Critical Worker Children and Vulnerable Pupils

However there will be no provision on site on Friday 5th March

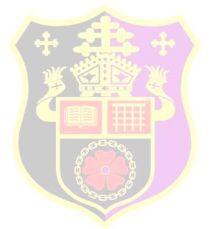
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Up to date contact details

If you change your contact details (address, mobile phone number or email address) you must let the school know immediately. Parents must ensure that the school constantly has two up to date contact telephone numbers.

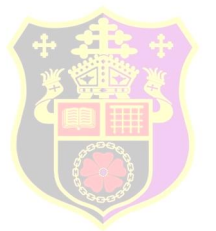

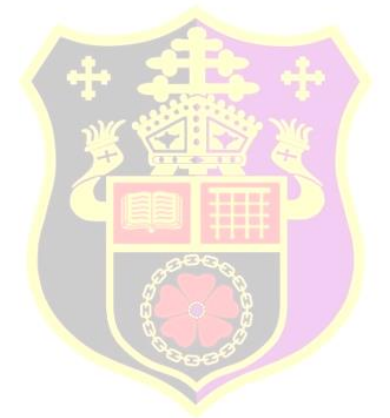

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Every Friday week B school will continue to finish at 2.20 for pupils although the exit will be staggered so the times will vary slightly

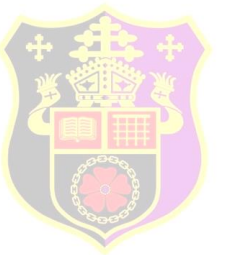
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Hygiene

- They should bring their own face coverings to school

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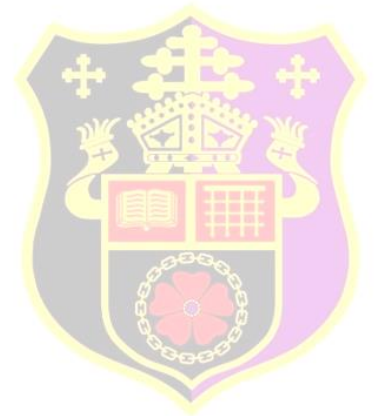


Parentmail

Please can **all** parents download the parentmail app onto their phones as this is our primary method of communication.



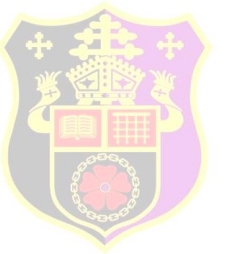
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Behaviour Policy

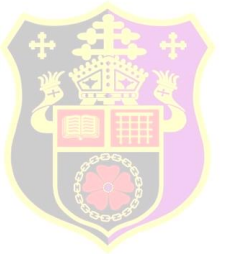
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Getting to School

- If you are dropping off your child please note that you will not be able to drive on to the school site. This is to ensure the safety of our students.

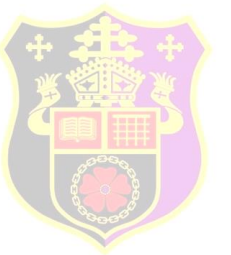
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Pupil Attendance

- Note: attendance for all pupils is mandatory

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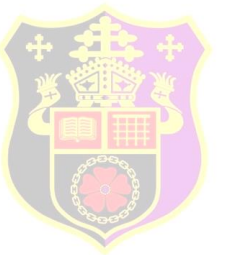

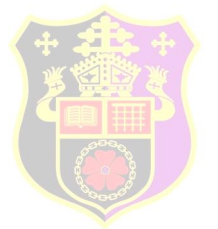

- You must ensure that your child brings their full pencil case of equipment every day. (including calculator)
 - Due to public health requirements we are not able to provide pupils with pens, pencils, calculators etc

Equipment

School Bag

Pupils must bring a school bag to school every day. The bag should be plain and large enough to hold A4 exercise books. Pupils must have an English dictionary in their bag.

Pencil Case

Pupils must have a well-stocked pencil case with them every day. Items required are:

- At least 2 black pens
- Glue stick
- 3 pencils, rubber and sharpener
- 2 green pen for reviewing your work
- A 30 cm ruler
- Maths Set including a protractor
- Coloured pencils
- 3 Highlighters (mixed colours)



A fully stocked pencil case can be purchased from student services for £5

Calculator

Pupils must bring a **scientific calculator** to every Maths lesson. These can be purchased from the Maths Office for £5.

Year 7, 8 and 9 Booklets

Please bring in all the booklets and materials that were collected from school just before half term.

They will be needed for lessons



Important

Hand Sanitizer

Please ensure that your son/daughter brings their own bottle of hand sanitizer and each day.

School Uniform

Blazer

Plain black blazer. The school badge must be sewn onto the front pocket. School badges are available from school only.

Shirt

White shirt with collar and buttons to the neck. The shirt must be long enough to be tucked into skirt or trousers.

Tie

Years 7 -10 – Red tie Year 11 – Black tie with red stripes. (For years 9 to 11 these will be provided by school)

Trousers and Socks

Plain black smart school trousers worn with black socks. Skin-tight or fashion trousers are not permitted. Trousers must not be tight around the ankle.

School Uniform

Skirt and Tights

Plain black traditional stitch-down pleated skirt. Must be worn with black tights. Stretchy fabrics are not permitted. Skirts are not to be worn with socks.

Jumper

Jumpers are optional. If pupils choose to wear a jumper it must be a plain black woollen V-neck. Sweatshirt fabric is not permitted.

Shoes

Plain black, traditional school shoes that can be polished and offer good support. Boots and shoes that look like trainers or pumps are not permitted. Air Force trainers are not permitted.

Coat

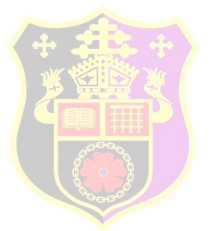
Plain, dark coloured coat. Jackets and fashion coats are not permitted.

Uniform

Normal uniform standards apply.

Pupils are expected to be in full and proper uniform every day

Please check that uniform fits!



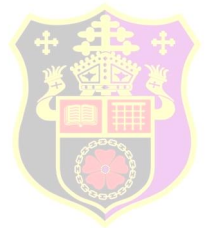
Hair

Hair colouring must be natural shades only.

Coloured or patterned extensions are not permitted.

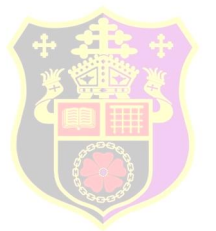
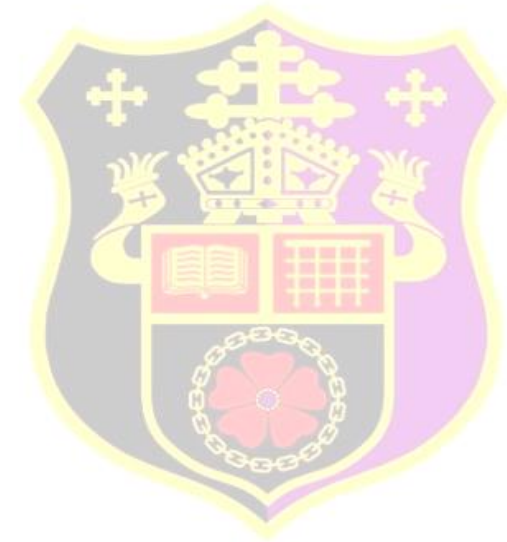
Adding coloured thread to braids is not permitted.

The school badge can be purchased from the school office for **£5.50**.

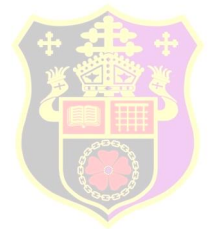


Safeguarding Contact

Please be assured that our Safeguarding and Pastoral Team are here and will support students on their return.

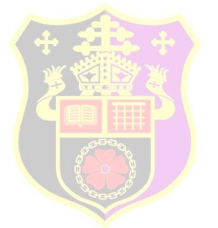


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Medical Information

All pupils who need to use inhalers must ensure that when you return, you have your inhaler on you at all times and you bring a spare one to be held with Student Services clearly labelled with your name.

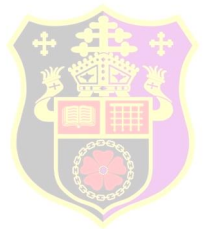
If you have an allergy that requires an EpiPen or other medication can you ensure you carry your personal EpiPen on you and you bring a spare one in to be held by Student Services and bring in any other appropriate medication for your allergies both clearly labelled with your name.



Lunch

Where possible, we encourage students to bring a packed lunch during the first term. However, we appreciate that this is not always possible.

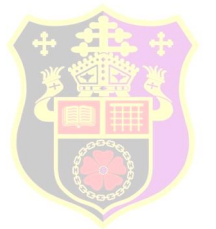
Free School Meals will, of course, still be provided.



Parent Pay

It is recommended that you preload your child's Parent Pay account with sufficient funds for lunch and break.

This will make lunch times much easier. Further details of how to preload payment has been included in the pack posted home.



Free School Meals

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.
