Policy Addendum: Behaviour



Behaviour policy Covid 19 Annex: 1st September 2020 until Further Notice

During this time we are required to adapt our behaviour policy and employ measures to ensure that the school is a safe environment for all staff and pupils. With this in mind this policy annex aims to ensure that all staff, pupils and parents are clear on what is expected of them regarding good and safe behaviour in school.

- If a student is experiencing symptoms of coronavirus they must tell an adult immediately. The student will be isolated in a safe place with supervision and parent/carer will be contacted and will be required to collect their son/daughter. The student must then self-isolate with their immediate family for 14 days.
- It is the expectation of the school that all students follow any altered routines for arrival or departure to the school. Any changes are to ensure the social distancing required to keep all staff and students safe during this time.
- Students must adhere to the school's instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising. Sanitiser and tissues for respiratory hygiene will be placed in all classrooms. Students must use tissues and dispose of them in the bin immediately ('catch it, bin it, kill it'). Hands must then be sanitised.
- As part of the social distancing and hygiene requirements sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles, food, computers, phones or any contact between individuals is not allowed.
- At the end of the day all pupils and students must leave the site immediately and make their way home without excessive congregation.
- To support the safety of the local community it is vital that this is adhered to on the journey to and from school.
- Students must follow any new rules regarding the safe movement around school. For example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas and queuing
- The use of the school toilets will be controlled and monitored to ensure hygiene standards are maintained. Hands must be sanitized prior to using the toilet facilities and afterwards, including the twenty second hand washing rule.
- The Head teacher holds it within his rights to sanction any student who does not adhere to all of the Covid 19 rule amendments set out in this St Edmund Campion School behaviour policy. The policy amendments are designed to keep all persons on the school site safe as well as the families to which they return at the end of the day. Breaking these rules could result in exclusion from the school site and may lead to further repercussions. Parents will be contacted and may be required to collect your son or daughter.
- Deliberate coughing or spitting at or towards any other person carry legal repercussions and will result in immediate exclusion from the school and possible further consequences.
- Any poor behaviour will be reported to the Governing Body and the Headteacher has the right to remove any students whose behaviour poses a risk to others.
